

Mound Westonka 4th grade basketball rules

We play Minnesota State High School Rules except where modified as stated below:

1. **Official Score Book:** We will provide the clockrunners but home team is responsible for providing official scorekeeper. Home team will be the second team listed on the schedule.
2. **Length of Game:** Two (2) – 20 minute running halves:
3. **Clock Stoppage:** The clock will stop the last two minutes of each half.
4. **Time Outs:** Each team is allowed Three (3) Time-Outs per game – Time-outs are not carried over into overtime. Each team will be granted one time-out for an overtime period.
5. **Overtime:** 1st overtime- 2 minutes stop time. Jump ball to begin overtime. Sudden Death after 1st overtime.
6. **Defenses:** Person to Person defense Only. Pressing will be allowed the last 2 minutes of each half, unless team is ahead by 15 pts.
7. **Halftime:** Four (4) minutes.
8. **Protests:** No protests will be considered. All disputes will be settled by the Referees and the Tournament Official on the spot.
9. **Basket Height:** All baskets will be regulation 10 feet.
10. **Three Point Shot:** Will be allowed.
11. **Free Throws:** Players will shoot foul shots when fouled in the act of shooting. Teams will also shoot 1 and 1 after 7 fouls and 2 shots after 10 team fouls per half. Players will be able to shoot from 12 ft.
12. **Technical Fouls:** Two points will be awarded along with the possession of the ball.
13. **Grace Period:** A grace period of 5 minutes will be allowed for your first game of the tournament. All other game times are subject to change. Games may start early, so have players ready 10 minutes prior to game time.
14. **Tie Breaker Rules:**
 - Head to Head
 - Avg Margin of Victory, not to exceed 15 pts
 - Fewest Points Allowed
 - Most Points Scored
